

Qualification for the Oregon Shootout Invitational (OSI) October 21 and 22, 2017

The Oregon Shootout Invitational is run by the Autocross Club of Central Oregon, which is solely responsible for determining which drivers qualify to compete. Their criteria state that the driver must have finished first or second in class in a club's championship, with scoring determined by each club's own rules. WMC's championship rules state that a driver must have competed in at least five club events during the year. Therefore, some WMC drivers who finished first or second in their class but only competed in less than five events will not be eligible to compete in the Shootout. We sought clarification from ACCO for the WMC drivers who ran four of our autocross events, but ACCO is bound by the Shootout qualification criteria that were published when the season began.

The following drivers will qualify for the Shootout based on participation in at least five WMC events. In some cases, the five events were split between two classes:
