**Safety:** You must wear an approved helmet (SA or SNELL 2005 or better) in order to compete. Some loaner helmets are available, but are in short supply. Shoes are required (no sandals or open toe shoes). Your car **MUST** be equipped with seat belts and be in good working order (brakes, tires, etc.) and must not be leaking fluids. No studded or temporary use tires. No loose items inside the car. No loose or bungee corded batteries, solid mount only.

**Noise restrictions are in place for this event, set at 92dB @ 50 feet. Strictly enforced!!!**  
**Additionally, this is an extremely noise sensitive venue. Any vehicle may be deemed Too Loud by the event organizers and be required to make an adjustment in order to continue competing.**
